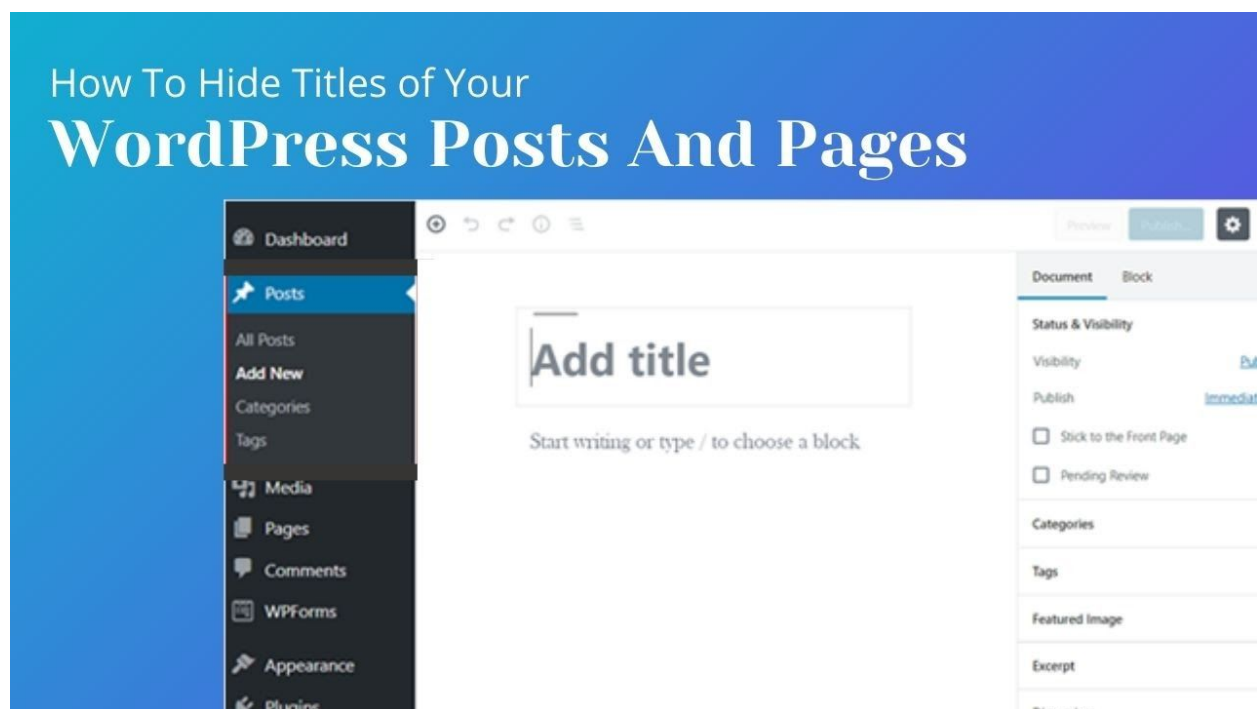


How To Hide Titles of Your WordPress Posts And Pages (2 Easy Ways)



WordPress is a multipurpose software, we all know that. Whether you want to build a gorgeous-looking website or take the content management control in your hand, it is always an ideal solution for us. However, it is also true that we don't use WordPress for these two purposes only.

There are lots of things we want to do with WordPress but its limitations don't allow us to do too much. And that's where we have to take help of a third-party tool or plugin to do exactly what we want. For instance, just take an example of WordPress posts and pages. We create it by putting a lot of time and effort into it and despite that sometimes we are not satisfied with its looks.

Generally, it happens that some WP themes position the title of our post or pages on the left by default. But we don't want it to be there, instead put in the center. Now that isn't going to be possible unless and until we customize or hide it. To customize the title you can simply use a page builder plugin, however to hide it completely you will have to leave the title section completely blank while creating a new post or page.

With that out of the way, now it's time to look at the two easy ways to hide the titles of your posts and pages in WordPress.

2 Easy Ways To Hide Post And Page Titles In WordPress

1. Leave The Title Section Empty

Perhaps, the easiest way to not display the title in some of your posts or pages is to simply not write anything in the title section when creating them. Not just this, you can also open your old blog posts and remove their titles if you don't want to show it to your users.

However, this method is not that easy as you might think. Because before you hide the title, you will have to first create a permalink for your post or page. And to do that you will have to write a title first and remove it then.

Besides that, one more thing you can do is to simply click on the edit button next to your permalink and change it to your liking. Now once you have entered the permalink of your choice, you can simply remove the title. And when you do that your permalink won't be affected and it will still be present there.

However, it is not that once you have removed the title of your posts or pages you won't need it in future. You will certainly need it to optimize your posts and pages for Google and still hide it for your users.

To do that, you can use an SEO plugin like All in One SEO that allows you to set a SEO title to display it in only search engines, not to your visitors.

2. Install A Page Builder Plugin With The Built-In Feature

Do you know what is the main reason for hiding the title in WordPress posts and pages? Because sometimes it is simply not required for the pages you create. Take for instance a landing page. We create it with a single purpose in mind and that is to bring our potential customers on our page and convince them to convert. Now in that case having a title on your landing page is absolutely not necessary because any user coming to your site through ads, emails, or social media platforms are already aware of the purpose of visiting your landing page.

Now the thing is whenever a webmaster or website owner creates a landing page, most of the time they use page builder plugins to do that. However, those plugins are not just good for creating or customizing your landing page but also hiding your titles. Yes, you heard it absolutely right! There are some [WordPress plugins](#) in the market that come with a built-in feature to hide titles.

Let's talk about Elementor here, which is one of the finest landing page builders available today. This plugin allows you to remove the title from your posts and pages with just one click. And it's not that Elementor is just available in the free version but also a pro version that offers loads of extra features. Such as you can create an opt-in form, use a number of templates and many more such things.

But as far as building landing pages and title removal goes, the free version is just enough to get your job done.

Now let's see how to hide the title in your WordPress post and pages using the Elementor plugin.

Step 1: Install and activate the Elementor plugin on your WordPress website.

Step 2: Go to the page or post from which you want to remove the title.

Step 3: Press that big and bold "Edit with Elementor" button.

You can see which button we are talking about in the picture above. Once you have done that, the Elementor page will open on your screen.

We have highlighted the title with a red line to show you that your post or page will still have it.

Step 4: Now look for a small settings icon at the bottom-left of the page and then click on it to remove your title.

Step 5: After you have clicked on the settings icon, you will land on the settings page. There you need to look for the Hide Title option and then enable it.

Now the title from your post or page is removed and it is completely ready to be added to your website.
